Dear hockey club members and families,

Enclosed you will find registration information for the upcoming season. There will be significant changes this year. We will again provide a safe and fun atmosphere for your child to learn and enjoy the great sport of ice hockey and we will add some new program options at a couple of the age groups.

This year we will roster up to nine age group teams in both girls and youth hockey classifications. This will include mites and mini-mites as well as girls U19. Girls will compete in the Mountain States Girls Hockey League and youth teams will compete in the Rocky Mountain Youth Hockey League.

In summary, you will notice many changes in the practice schedule. Our intent is to contain cost increase by reducing the number of practice slots but, not the weekly ice time hours, in order to reduce the ice maintenance requirements from the Town. Games will again happen on weekends. Year-end tournaments and playoffs will wrap up the season by the weekend of March 6 and 7, 2010 for most teams. A team that qualifies for the CAHA tournament by winning the league title will play the weekend of March 19 - 21. Please see all the important dates on page 5 of this guide. Due to the expected growth in membership we must limit the registration for a child to one team or age group.

The intent of the hockey club is to field one team in each competitive age group this year. Our mite program will be conducted with all the kids from birth years 2001-2004 sharing and separating ice time for practice and competing in groups of similar skill. Our competitive travel teams will play in the following USAHOCKEY age groups: squirt, peewee, bantam, midget, and Girls U19. Our hockey club has made a commitment to field a competitive team in each of our affiliate leagues. **Our mission of providing a fun hockey opportunity for all kids who want to play remains our highest priority.** Should it become necessary, the Lizard Head Hockey Club reserves the right in their sole discretion, to place players of any age or gender on the team that the hockey club board of directors and the coaches feel is most appropriate in order to maintain the integrity, viability and manageability of any of our hockey teams. Other changes and important information for each team or age group is presented below.

### **Parent Education Program**

A requirement of all CAHA member families is a required on-line registration. This registration will begin a series of on-line letters and media related to hockey player parental education. The registration is easy and done at [www.coloradoavalanchecares.com/join/](http://www.coloradoavalanchecares.com/join/). All families must be registered by one parent no later than November 1. Our registration will be reviewed and **families not registered risk the suspension of their player(s) eligibility**. Please take the very small amount of time required to meet this important requirement.

### **Hockey Club and Town of Telluride Parks and Recreation Partnership**

The Hockey Club and the Parks and Recreation Department have enjoyed a long running and very successful partnership in providing the youth hockey program. In general, Parks and Recreation provide the management and maintenance of the ice facility, serve as the registrar, schedule ice and competition, and arrange for officiating. The hockey club provides the organization structure for the promotion of our program, arranges for the training and certification of our coaching staff, organizes and conducts fund raising, provides league affiliation representatives and provides for the strategic direction and planning for the Telluride hockey program.

### **Girls Hockey**

U19 Girls hockey is for girls who have birth years 1990 - 1996. We will register one girls team and they will play a full schedule in the MSGHL. On ice with the U19 will be Davis Fansler and John Cohn.

### **Travel Team Squirt**

Travel Team Squirt hockey is for both boy and girl players born in 1999 and 2000. This year the squirts will play a regional RMYHL schedule and a special invitational tournament should the opportunity arise. The league will hold a championship tournament in a location to be announced in early March. The champion of that tournament will qualify for the state tournament in Denver at the Pepsi Center two weeks later. Regional RMYHL teams include Gunnison, Durango, Crested Butte and Grand Junction. The Head Coach will be Steve Swenson. Kevin Green and Steve Green will also be on the ice and in the bench with Coach Swenson. The team will be comprised of 15 players selected by tryout. Players hoping for a roster spot will be individually evaluated by an independent professional working with the coaching staff. Those players not selected will have the in-house U12 program as an option with a fee credit to be returned on election of that option. Travel team squirts will have their own practices.
